Scripture: Colossians 3:23-24 (NIV)

Synopsis: Every believer is divinely called, uniquely gifted, and purposed to glorify God in their work, no matter their vocation.

<u>What I know about work:</u>

I. Your work has ______ in God's eyes.

Colossians 3:23a – Whatever you do, ...

All that you do in life belongs to God, and that includes your work.

Your workplace is your mission field.

You were created for a purpose.

Ephesians 2:10 – For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

II. Your work ______ reflects your devotion.

<u>Colossians 3:23b</u> – ... work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters,

How you do your work matters just as much as what you do.

When you see your job as service to the Lord, it changes everything.

Your highest calling is to glorify God in all you do.

<u>**1** Corinthians 10:31</u> – So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

III. Your _____ comes from the Lord.

<u>Colossians 3:24</u> – Since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

There are no unimportant jobs in the kingdom of God.

<u>**1** Corinthians 12:6</u> – There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

<u>God promises an eternal inheritance to those who work</u> <u>faithfully for Him.</u>

<u>Matthew 25:21</u> – *His master replied, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!"*
